Introduced:	Originally available in 2006 as part of the seasonal Michelob specialty line, Michelob Porter is now available year-round.
Beer Category/Style:	High End/Specialty Seasonal – Brown Porter
Taste Profile:	Slightly bitter malty brew, with pronounced caramel and coffee notes.
Ingredients/Brewing:	Brewed using the finest classic aroma hop varieties grown in the Pacific Northwest and two-row, caramel and chocolate barley malts, giving it an aroma of coffee and a hint of chocolate. It is dark brown in color and, when held to light, ruby-red highlights can be seen.
How to Serve:	Michelob Porter complements a variety of cheeses, shellfish dishes as well as chocolate desserts. Enjoy it in a traditional pub-style glass to highlight the beer's creaminess.
Interesting Facts:	This style of beer was favored by laborers (“porters”) in 18 th century London, which is how it obtained its name.
